Is the Anchor a Christian Symbol?

The anchor became a key Christian symbol during the period of Roman persecution. The image of the anchor echoes Hebrews 6:19: "We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure." Epitaphs on believers' tombs dating as far back as the end of the first century frequently displayed anchors alongside messages of hope. (copied)
